Inherent Risk:

Skiing/snowboarding is a sport with physical demands and inherent risks which are beyond the control of the snow resort. Falls, collisions and other incidents may occur and cause injury. Skiers/snowboarders must assume the risks and dangers.

Equipment:

The snow resort will provide rental equipment. Bindings on equipment reduce the risk of injury when falling. They will not release under all circumstances and they do not guarantee safety in all cases. Helmets must be worn by all participants during Alpine excursions.

Alpine Responsibility Code:

The Ontario Snow Resorts Association, in collaboration with Ontario School Board Insurance Exchange (OSBIE), has produced an Alpine Responsibility Code which Snow Resorts require that students know and obey. Skiers/snowboards must always ski/snowboard in control.

The Snow Resort may revoke a ski ticket for violation of the code or other unacceptable conduct.
