### ***IS MY BUS CANCELLED TODAY?***

All schools in Algonquin and Lakeshore Catholic District School Board, Hastings and Prince Edward District School Board, Limestone District School Board, Conseil des écoles publiques de l'Est de l'Ontario and Conseil des écoles Catholiques de Langue Francaise du Centre-Est (Kingston and Trenton area) and Whitney Public School will remain open in the event of full bus cancellation unless otherwise determined by the Director(s) of Education.

#### **Morning Cancellations:**

It is a consensus that the Bus Operators/Tri-Board Student Transportation Services Inc staff are in the best position to determine whether or not buses should run. In this regard the following will apply:

#### **Inclement Weather**

**Bus routes cancelled due to inclement weather are cancelled for the whole day. Inclement weather includes winter fog. Parents/guardians will be responsible for the return transportation for any student dropped off at school.**

#### **Fog Cancellations - Spring and Fall**

**When a bus does not travel a route in the morning due to heavy fog, and the fog clears during the day, that bus will pick up students in the afternoon for the return journey. In the event the fog does not lift during the day, a decision to cancel afternoon runs will be made by 12:00 p.m. with schools being notified of the decision at that time. Parents/guardians will be responsible for the return transportation for any student dropped off at school.**

#### **How to access information on delays or cancellations through our website:**

School Administration and Parents/Guardians may obtain information regarding bus cancellations or delays by accessing the Tri-Board Student Transportation Services website at [www.triboard.on.ca](http://www.triboard.on.ca). Cancellations/delays will be posted on the website as early as possible. Tri-Board Student Transportation Services Inc serves an area from Algonquin Park in the north and west to Trenton in the south west and from Sharbot Lake in the north east to Gananoque in the south east. Weather patterns can vary from one area to another. Parents/guardians and school personnel are encouraged to log into the Tri-Board website daily to view any cancellations and delays caused by weather or mechanical problems that may affect students. The Tri-Board home page will display a message indicating whether there are any buses that are delayed or cancelled that day.

To view route status:

Go online to [www.triboard.on.ca](http://www.triboard.on.ca)

Look at "Is My Bus Running" at the top left side of the webpage

Select a school and view the status of all routes into that school **OR**

Type in a bus number and view the status of that individual bus route.

Click on the "sign up" area on our home page (upper right area of home page) to receive an email/text notification of cancellations/delays affecting the bus you sign up for.

#### **How to access information on delays or cancellations through the media:**

A listing of school bus cancellations/delays are available to the local radio stations and will be announced to the public beginning at 6:00 a.m. Below is a listing of all of the radio and television stations that will be receiving information from Tri-Board Student Transportation Service Inc regarding cancellations and/or delays.
